*Target of the prize is to promote contemporary chamber music and creating opportunities for composers and performers to meet.*

**RULES**

The Call for Scores is open to composers of any nationality up to 40 years old (not completed in the current year). Applicants must send 2 compositions, either for solo instrument or chamber group (max 15 elements); electronic instrumentation is not allowed. Compositions can be either both for one instrument, or both for ensemble, or mixed. The submission of pieces presenting various instrumentation is suggested. The MP3 recording of just one of the pieces is also required.

Compositions can be written in any style and aesthetic.

Max time: 15 (fifteen) minutes each.

Pieces can have already been performed. Pieces can have already been awarded a prize.

Members of the jury will be **Alberto E. Colla (Ita)**, **Alissa Firsova (Eng/Rus)** and **Anna Pidgorna (Ukr/Can)**. They will choose a single winner, who will receive a prize of € 750,00.

In addition to that, the winner will be asked to compose a piece expressly for the winner of the *XX CENTURY PRIZE* (either soloist or group), awarded to the best execution of a piece composed after 1950, in the 23<sup>d</sup> edition of International Chamber Music Competition LUIGI NONO, which will take place in Settimo (Turin) from October 25<sup>th</sup> through October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The commissioned piece will be premiered by the winner/s of the *XX CENTURY PRIZE* in a concert within the 2020 concert season organized by *Amici per la Musica - Associazione culturale* (the concert is part of the prize for the winner/s). The composer will be invited to attend the concert. In that occasion he/she will be given the prize (cheque).

Unfortunately the organizers are not able to cover any accommodation and travelling expenses.

The performance will be professionally recorded. Both the composer and the organisers of the competition will be free to use the record for their activity.

The name of the winner will be posted on the website of the Competition [www.amiciperlamusica.com](http://www.amiciperlamusica.com) within the beginning of LUIGI NONO Competition (October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019). The results will be also announced during the awarding ceremony of LUIGI NONO Competition: Sunday, October 27<sup>th</sup> 2019. The winner will be informed by e-mail, as well.

The submitted scores will be considered property of *Amici per la Musica – Associazione culturale* and will not be returned.
